WORD

Revelation 12:7-9

7 Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back, 8 but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. 9 And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Satan has lost the battle with God and eventhough ha has the lost the battle, he is currently winning the battle in the lives of many people. On this series, we are learning to fight, a fight that is not physical but a fight that is within us. The hardest fight that we wage against ourselves. First week, we learn how to fight fears that is within and that God is our Shepherd (Psalm 23), Second week, we learn to fight disillusionment and that we have the Advocate, the Holy Spirit who is our helper (John 14:15-17a) and this week, we will learn to fight deception.

Deception refers to the act of manipulating, misleading or tricking someone into believing something that is not true. Often for personal gain or to cause harm. People will try to deceive us for personal gain and harm us. Deception is a powerful force. In fact deception can take many forms, but ultimately has one goal. To lead us away from what is true. To lead us away from the truth. To lead us away from God. And deception is described as one of Satan's main weapons in reaching his ultimate goal, which is to keep us away from God and His salvation.He wants to prevent us from finding true joy, peace, and love in our lives. He does this by deceiving us into thinking that we don't need God, or that we can find all we are looking for without God.
